For divisions with no less than 8 fighters, medals and awards will be presented to champion, runner-up, and tied-third place.

For divisions with less than 8 fighters, medals and awards will be presented to champion, and runnerup.

VI. Applicable Rules and Regulations

- Generally accepted Kyokushin Karate tournament rules apply, unless specified otherwise in this document
- 2) Kumites will be refereed by 5 judges/referees, majority rule apply: any "scoring" or "foul" needs to be supported by at least 3 judges/referees to be deemed effective, and each of the referees, chief and assistant alike, have 1 vote for the winner of the bout regardless.
- 3) Single defeat elimination is in effect for all Kumites
- 4) Kumites:
 - a. There are no limits on the number of fighters from participating teams. Participating teams are allowed to determine the size and composition of their roster of fighters as they see fit.
 - b. Consult Section V (2) for information concerning age & weight divisions

*Adult Elites Male Divisions: Groin guards, shin guards, and gloves are mandatory. Mouthguard is optional.

VII. Medals and Awards

- For divisions with no less than 8 fighters, medals and awards will be presented to champion, runnerup, and tied-third place. For divisions with less than 8 fighters, medals and awards will be presented to champion, and runner-up.
 - a.# of fighters will be determined after division-merging has been performed as per specified in Section VII (2).
 - b. Medalists will receive medals and honorary certificates according to their rankings.
- 2) Divisions may be either 1) merged into another adjacent division or 2) cancelled, if there are less than 4 fighters registered in the division after the registration deadline as specified in section X (1).

VIII. Disclaimers and Instructions

- Participants must adhere to rules and regulations of the Tournament and obey commands of the tournament committee and judges/referees at all times,
- 2) Participants must follow rules and regulations as specified in this document during their participation in the Tournament. In case of sports injuries due to fouls, the participant committing the foul, the team of the participant committing the foul, and the insurance companies (if applicable) will be held

solely responsible. In case of sports injuries due to reasons other than fouls, the participant will be solely responsible. The Tournament committee will not be responsible in any case.

- Participants who are not citizens of the People's Republic of China may represent themselves and/or their organizations. Participants will not be allowed to represent countries.
- Subject to selection by the Tournament committee, invited organizations & dojos may recommend qualified individuals as referees:
 - a.Qualifications required: Chief Referee candidates: 4th Dan or above; Assistant Referee candidates: 1st Dan to 3rd Dan.
- 5) Dress Code and Etiquette for Referees:
 - a.Dress Code: dark blue shirt, navy blue pants, dark-colored socks, whistle, bow ties (yellow for assistant referees, white for chief referees)
 - Etiquette: jewelries, watches, cellphones, name tags, any other items & accessories that might be expected to interfere with the fight are not allowed on the mat
- 6) Dress Code and Etiquette for Participants:

a. Dress Code: Karate gis that are allowed by the Tournament Committee.

- b. Etiquette: protective gears prepared by the Participants must be checked and cleared by the Tournament Committee before being used. The check-in staff of the Tournament reserve the right to inspect the Participants' gis and protective gears, and the Participants are obligated to comply. No hard objects allowed on the mat.
- 7) Corner-man / ring-side coaches: must be dressed presentably and must act responsibly.

IX. Rules Concerning Kumites

- Participants must not misrepresent necessary personal information include age, weight, division, and height when registering for the Tournament. Any misrepresentation will subject the participant to disciplinary actions including immediate disqualification and public disclosure of the incident.
- 2) Weigh in: the weigh in will take place when the Participants check-in at the specified venue, on the day of tournament. Participants not being able to make the weight will be penalized as follows:

a. Miss by less than 1 kg: automatic 1 point penalty during fights

- b. Miss by more than 1 kg: automatic disqualification.
- 3) During the course of the tournament, the Participants must stay within the designated area. If a Participant must leave the venue for unforeseen circumstances, the Participant must: inform the Tournament officials or their team officials, and return on time. Failure to show up on time will result in automatic disqualification due to "no contest".
- 4) During fights, only 1 corner-man / ring-side coach (per fighter) is allowed to enter fight area and provide support and instructions as the corner-man / ring-side coach.
- 5) Ring-side coach must act in a responsible and composed manner and must not interfere with the normal course of the fight. Behaviors such as rattling the mat will not be tolerated.

a.In case of violation, the Chief Referee in charge reserve the right to warn the ring-side coach, to issue a warning to the fighter, and to order for removal of the ring-side coach.

6) Appeals:

For appeals of referee rulings, the Participants must report to the Tournament committee through their team officials. No appeal directly from the Participants or their coaches will be accepted. For appeals submitted and accepted, the Tournament committee will determine whether to overrule the original ruling. The Tournament committee has the right of final interpretation, and its ruling is final.

7) The Tournament committee reserve the right to disqualify Participants who refuse to follow the committee's instructions and Participants who are interfering with the progression of the Tournament.

X. Registration, Announcement of Fight-card, and Check-in

- 1) Registration:
 - a.Deadline: November 1st, 2019
 - b. Information to be submitted to the Tournament committee in writing includes: Name of the organization, number of members of the organization, the Participant's biological sex, age, weight, division. All Participants must present valid, government-issued photo ID or Hukou (for P.R.C nationals.) at check in.
- 2) Announcement of Fight-card: November 20th, 2019
- 3) Check-in:
 - a.Pre-fight Check-in: November 29th, 2019
 - b. Team officials will be issued their fighter identification numbers and souvenirs at Check-in.
- 4) Registration: CNY 250 / person (including premium for mandatory insurance policy)
